  - a. Fire Dept
    - i. The report was provided prior to the meeting.

  - b. Crittenden AMB District:
    - i. The report was provided prior to the meeting.
    - ii. Burton:
      1. Discussions are ongoing between the Grant County AMB District / Dry Ridge AMB Service / Crittenden AMB District
      2. The County received an outside bid to provide the AMB service to the county - \$1.235 million cost per year.
      3. I am unsure if anyone believes a private service is best for Grant County.
      4. Newman: Where would the vendor be staging the AMB equipment?
        - a. Burton: I do not have that information.
      5. Grant County projected revenue: \$1.36 million per fiscal year from the current AMB district. This does not include the Crittenden AMB District.
